### ➤ **JUNE 16-22    ADVANCED WEEK OF RIDING 12 YRS+**

This week is special for advanced riders who wish to improve and enjoy the skills they already have. Ages 12 and over please. Requirements are walk/trot/canter skills, along with some basic dressage and jumping.

### ➤ **JUNE 23-29    JUMPING WEEK    no age limit, (basic skills needed)**

Jumping skills are worked on during this week of fun. Learn to jump or work on your skills in the ring and out of the ring. Riders should already have basic skills to begin jumping or continue their jumping lessons in this week. X-country will be included (weather permitted)

### ➤ **JUNE 30-JULY 6    HOLIDAY FUN WEEK OF CAMP    ages 8-18**

This "4<sup>th</sup> of July" week will center on trail riding, basic riding lessons at all levels, swimming with the horses, games on horseback, and lots of important ground lessons for everyone. A special *picnic at the lake is included* for this Holiday week of horse camp.

### ➤ **JULY 7-13    LEARN NEW SKILLS WEEK    ANY AGES    8-18 years**

For our intro riders of any age, this week will teach basics to all ages of riders who are not advanced enough to participate in other weeks. We will specialize in walk/trot/canter/ basic safety and riding skills, trail riding, dressage introduction, and intro to jumping for those able to. We will also include Western and English and bareback riding in this week of fun and lots and lots of riding and horses for everyone. Learn to swim a horse in the lake, trail ride like a pro, and ride Western or English during your lessons. Any ages are welcome .

### ➤ **JULY 14-20    CROSS COUNTRY JUMPING WEEK    basic skills needed**

Our most popular week includes learning to ride cross country on your horse (or mine). Lots of jumping (in and out of the ring). Learn to jump combinations, logs, oxers, bank jumps, tires, ...in the field! Riders will learn to control their horses "out of the ring" during this week of riding.

Basic requirements of w/t/canter and some jump experience is necessary.

### ➤ **JULY 21-27    FINAL SHOW WEEK OF SEASON    any ages this week.**

Our final week of camp will cover all aspects of "showing" for riders who may want to expand their skills to the show ring. We will teach you about dressage, equitation, pleasure, games offered at shows, jumping courses, barrel racing, key-hole race, cross country and hunter pace shows, ...just about every type of show that a rider may be interested in. We practice every day for events, and at the end of the week, parents arrive at 10am, and we actually have a SHOW ☺ lots of fun, classes, and ribbons for everyone, and it will fill up quickly... join us.....
