ATTACH YOUR MEDICAL CARD TO THE PACKAGE AND RETURN TO FARM WITH A \$150 DEPOSIT FOR EACH WEEK OF CAMP. YOUR BALANCE WILL NOT BE DUE UNTIL YOU ARRIVE AT THE FARM.
